



Visit to Southampton: Monday April 23rd 2018

Southampton is an old port with a long history and despite extensive damage during World War II, there are still many places of historic interest to visit on a day out. These include the medieval walls and buildings, links to Jane Austen, SeaCity Museum [includes Titanic exhibition], the City Art Gallery and of course the modern shopping centre.

Details of the day -

- Date of trip: Monday 23rd April
- Meet at Bath station to catch the 9.36 train to Southampton Central. Train ticket to be purchased individually; current off-peak prices are £27.50/ £18.36 with senior rail card.
- On arrival the day would begin with a walk led by a Blue Badge Guide around the Old Town highlighting places of interest. The walk would last approximately 1 hour 15 minutes and conclude centrally, close to the Art Gallery, SeaCity Museum, shops and cafes.
- There would then be free time for people to explore the Gallery/Museum/shops according to preference, either with the group or on their own if they wish.
- We would aim to return on the 16.10 train to Bath, to avoid the rush hour.
- Cost for Guided Walk - Members £12: Guests £14. Please make cheques payable to The Arts Society Bath.
